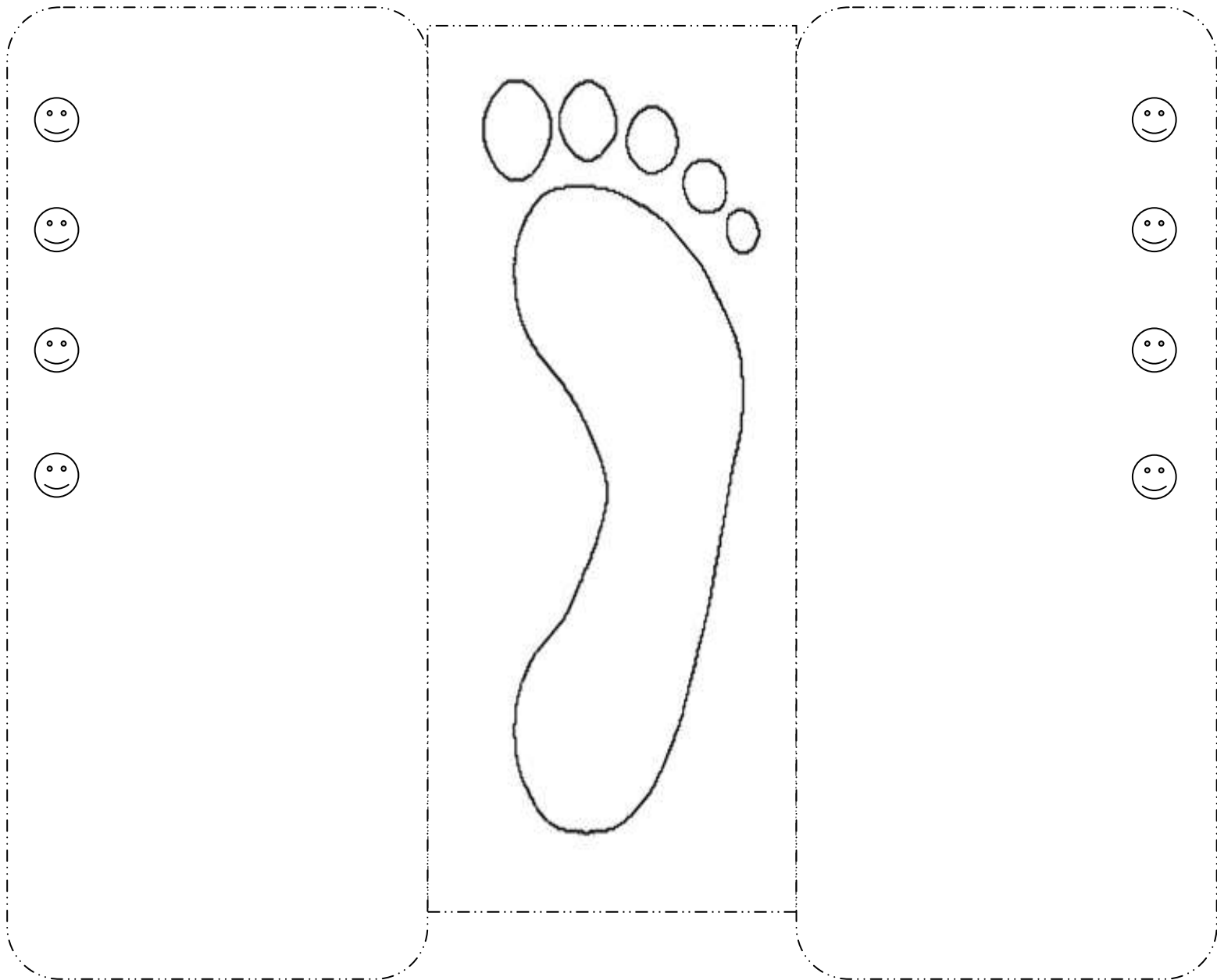
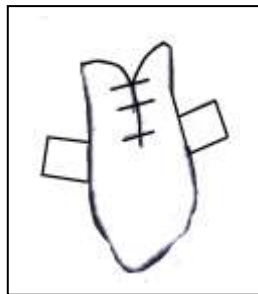
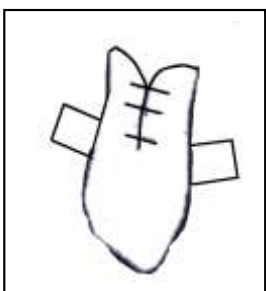
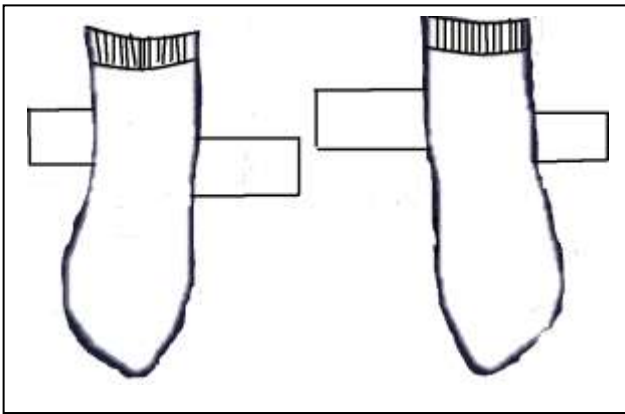
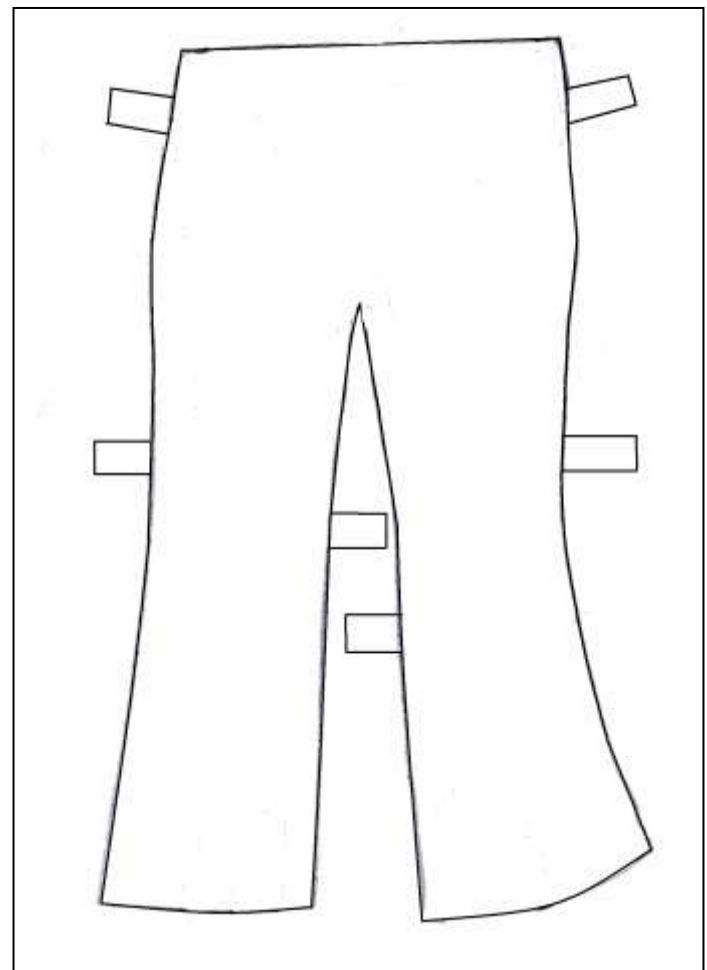
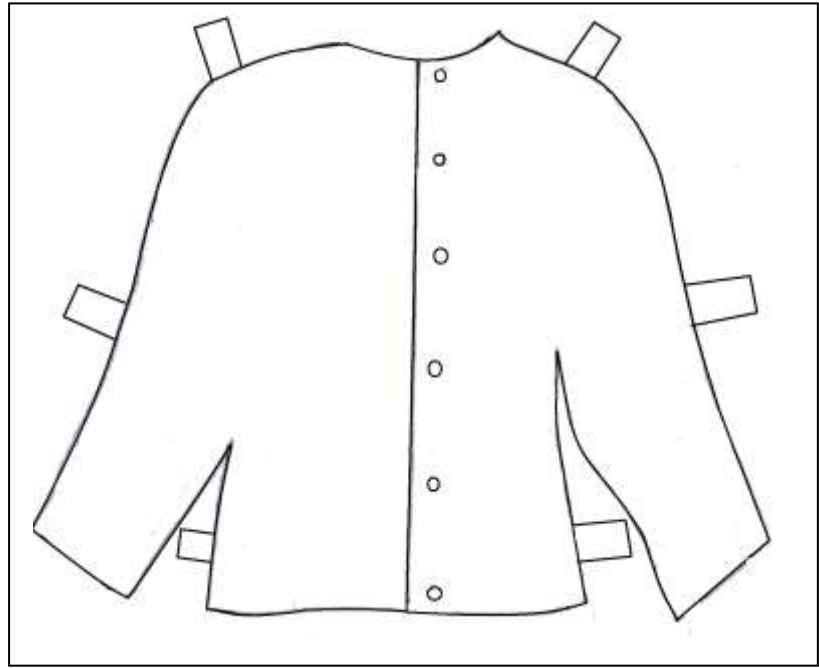
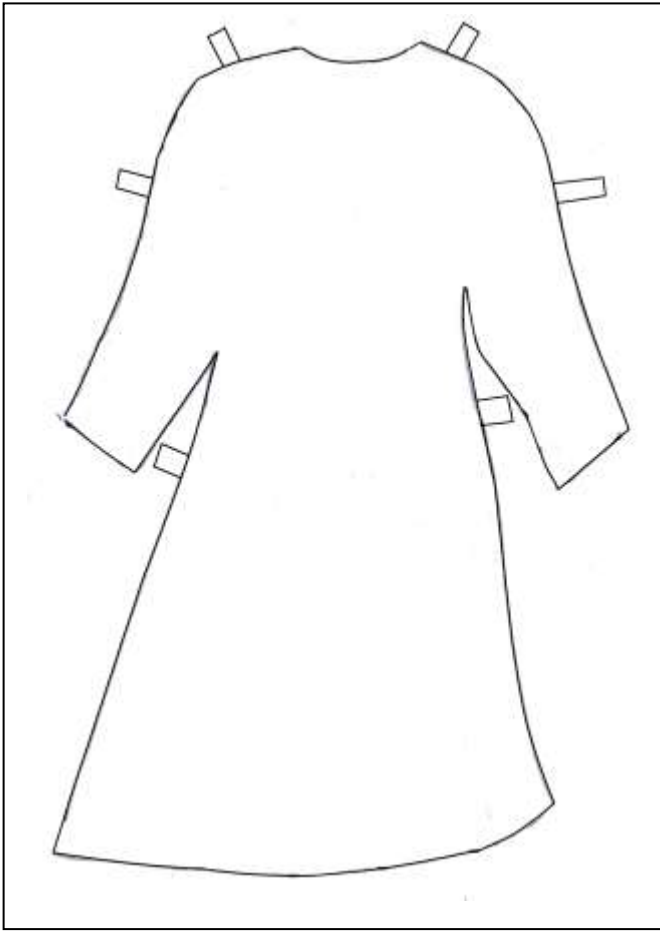


Dressing – Book 8 – LEVEL 0



Activity 1: Make a photocopy of the picture of the footprint on cardboard. Cut it out neatly on the dotted lines and make holes where indicated. The aim of the activity is to get learners to thread their “shoes” and to tie them independently. The learner places his/her foot on the footprint and wraps the flaps of the “shoe” around the sides of the foot. Learners must try to thread the laces through the holes and tie the laces themselves. For the tying of the shoelace, break the activity up into smaller steps, making sure they master one step before moving on to the next step. When the learner has mastered the task, he/she can colour in the “shoe” and decorate it. It can then be taken home and parents can be shown how they have mastered this life skill

Activity 2: Make enough photocopies of the paper dolls on cardboard as well as the clothing on ordinary paper. Encourage the learners to colour in the clothing and the doll and to cut out the clothes and doll. Show them how to dress their doll in different items. The learners can design and make more clothes for their doll.
